

DIRECTIONS TO LONG BEACH GENERATING STATION

FROM LAX

- Merge onto Sepulveda Blvd South / CA-1S toward Hwy 105.
- After the tunnel take the on ramp for Hwy 105 towards Norwalk.
- Move to the right lanes; take I-405S towards Long Beach.
- Take I-405S to the 710 freeway, approximately 12 to 13 miles.
- After passing the Alameda off ramp, move to the right hand lanes.
- Take the 710S toward Long Beach (stay to the left entering the 710).
- Travel approximately 3.5 miles; you will see a sign for "Port of LB/ Queen Mary," stay in the right lanes and follow direction.
- Shortly after you will see a sign for "Port of LB Terminal Island," move to the left lanes and follow, this will take you onto the Desmond Bridge.
- After cresting the bridge move to the right hand lane. Towards the bottom of the bridge you will take the first exit on the right, "Pier T."
- Follow the road around to the stop sign; take a left under the bridge towards Piers 116 and 118; once you have passed under the bridge keep to the left and enter into the center gate and drive toward park signage.

FROM THE SOUTH

- Take I-5N to I-405/I-5N; transition to the 405N (Long Beach).
- Continue on I-405N through Long Beach to the 710S (transition is after the Long Beach Blvd and the 710N exit).
- Exit I-405 onto the 710S toward Long Beach (stay to the left when entering the 710).
- Travel approximately 3.5 miles; you will see a sign for "Port of LB/ Queen Mary," stay in the right lanes and follow direction.
- Shortly after you will see a sign for "Port of LB Terminal Island," move to the left lanes and follow, this will take you onto the Desmond Bridge.
- After cresting the bridge move to the right hand lane. Towards the bottom of the bridge you will take the first exit on the right, "Pier T."
- Follow the road around to the stop sign; take a left under the bridge towards Piers 116 and 118; once you have passed under the bridge keep to the left and enter into the center gate and drive toward park signage.
